



DevOps Enterprise: Lessons Learned

- →On Nov. 7-9, we held the third DevOps Enterprise Summit, a conference for horses, by horses
- →Speakers included fifty leaders from:

Observations

- They were using the same technical practices and getting the same sort of metrics as the unicorns
 - ◆Target: 100+ deploys per week, < 10 incidents per month, enabled 53 business initiatives
 - →Capital One: 100s of deploys per day, lead time of minutes
 - Macy's: 1,500 manual tests every 10 days, now 100Ks automated tests run daily
 - Disney: Has embedded nearly 100 Ops engineers into LOB teams across the enterprise
 - Nationwide Insurance: Retirement Plans app (COBOL on mainframe)
 - →Raytheon: testing and certification from months to a day
 - →US CIS: security and compliance testing run every code commit

We formulate hypotheses; validate them with experience and data



Pipeline has access to systems, **NOT** people

Infrastructure as code

Compute, DB, Storage, Network

When we do Agile and DevOps

Fraud detection: implemented grouping fraud check in 6 weeks compared to original 12 weeks estimate.

Gain: 6 weeks worth of fraud reduction from 100k to 100s conditions.

HPE micro services split: from 1 production instances to 3 with no additional personnel

Fraud detection: from 10h business downtime for upgrade to **0 downtime**.

Fraud detection: 1 user ticket (97% decrease from FY14)

Partner portal: **1 month turnaround** to stand up new v1 networking sub-portal

Employee survey: "My organization has implemented processes that effectively support our ability to be an innovative company. **+10%** to 75%" (source: RnD IT survey results)


